RE: Situation around Ukraine

Dear Friends and Clients,

We continue to update you with information about Ukraine, Nikopol, and our production facilities. As a reliable partner, we believe we should provide you with the status of our production processes, and the current situation in Nikopol and in Ukraine, which may look different from the reports in newspapers.

We are monitoring all sources of information at our disposal, including government agencies, ministries, and personal connections who are politically involved in the crisis. We believe the current consensus among experts is that the chance of the “hot” war is negligent. It looks like the conflict is localized in the far east of Ukraine in the small breakaway “Republics”, which have already been under de-facto Russian control for last eight years.

We have not seen any movements of military personnel or equipment in Nikopol, Dnipro, Zaporizhia, or Kiev. The two local airports in Dnipro and Zaporizhia are working as always, as are the major railway stations. The entire economic infrastructure: banks, restaurants, supermarkets, and supply chains in general continue to work without any interruptions and without any shortages of food, goods, and services.

All production facilities in Centravis are fully loaded and working with an expected run rate. All of your orders are being handled in a timely manner.

You, our valued clients, supported us during much scarier times of the Crimean and Donbas crisis in 2014-2015. We are relying on your understanding and partnership during such events that we are currently witnessing in Europe.
